LabStats API Terms of Use

In order to utilize the LabStats API, you must agree to these terms of use:

- a) You will do the following:
 - i) Make all requests to the API with encrypted connections.
 - ii) Protect and keep secret your API keys to prevent unauthorized access of your LabStats data by unauthorized persons. You will revoke any unneeded keys or those which may have been compromised, including those which may have been unsafely transmitted (via email, chat, unencrypted requests, among others) or stored in plain text.
 - iii) Accept all responsibility for the access of data through the API following the creation and configuration of your API keys, and hold LabStats harmless for any access of data through the use of your API keys.
 - iv) Comply with all applicable laws and regulations in your use of API data, including those concerning student and user privacy.
- b) You will not do the following
 - i) Abuse the service, intentionally or unintentionally, with excessive API requests including denial of service attacks.

Some portions of the LabStats API make use of Google's Maps Platform, and therefore, in addition to agreeing with the previous terms, you must also recognize that you are bound by Google's Terms of Service.
